What is the Mandatory Bursary?

The Mandatory Bursary is a means-tested annual payment made to eligible students to assist with studying expenses.

What is it worth?

The Mandatory Bursary is £338 for 2011/12.

Am I eligible to receive the Mandatory Bursary?

Students who receive the **full** (£2,906) Maintenance Grant or Special Support Grant and pay the full fee (£3,375 for academic year 2011/12) will be eligible for the Mandatory Bursary of £338.

What is the full Higher Education Maintenance Grant?

The full Higher Education Maintenance Grant is available to new full-time Higher Education students starting a course from September 2011 who are from households with a family income of £25,000 per annum or less. Applications should be made via Student Finance England/Wales/N. Ireland. You do not have to repay the Maintenance Grant.



What do I need to do to receive the Bursary if I am eligible?

You will receive a 'University or College Payment Advice' letter from Student Finance England/Wales/N.Ireland telling you if you are entitled to the full Higher Education Maintenance Grant or Special Support Grant.

You must provide a copy of this letter to our Scholarship & Bursary Office at the earliest opportunity. No Mandatory Bursary payment will be processed if we do not receive this letter.

How and when will the Bursary funds be awarded?

September/October starters

You will be asked to complete a 'Confirmation of Eligibility' task in your e:Vision account at the start of your second semester with us to confirm your eligibility. Payment will be made direct into your bank account at the end of February 2012.

February starters

You will be asked to complete a 'Confirmation of Eligibility' task in your e:Vision account during June 2012 to confirm your eligibility. Payment will be made direct into your bank account at the end of August 2012.

How will you know my bank account/building society details?

You should go to your e:Vision account <https://e-vision.anglia.ac.uk> to enter your bank account details and to confirm that they have been entered correctly. Our system will know when you have done this, ensuring that payments can be made.

It is very important that you check and confirm your bank account details in e:Vision, which you can do at any time. It is your responsibility to ensure that the data we hold is correct and up-to-date.
